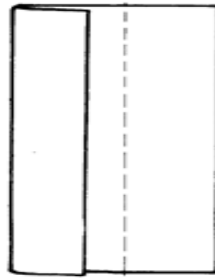


Prefold Diaper Folding Techniques

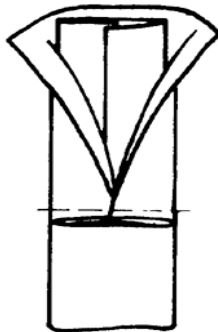
This fold can be used with either **newborn or toddler-size**, pre folded diapers. It gives excellent absorbency and a trim fit.



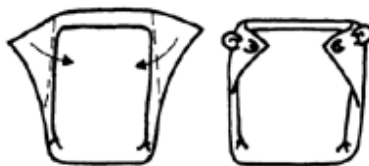
1. Fold the sides of the diaper across the center panel to form a pad.



2. Fold a small portion of the diaper up in the front.

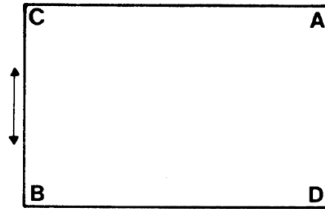


3. Unfold the sides at the back of the diaper to form two wings.

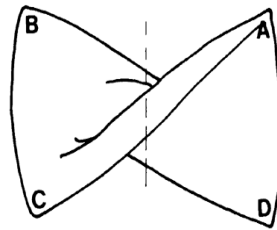


- Place the diaper under the baby. Bring the front of the diaper up between the baby's legs.
- Bring the two wings around from the back and pin. Be sure to push the pin through only a few layers of fabric. It is not necessary to push the pin through all the layers of cotton. ~ use a snappi!

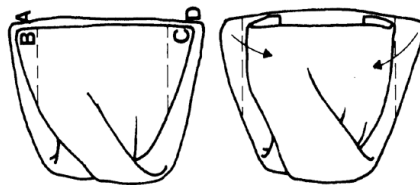
TODDLER FOLD



- Start with a toddler-size diaper.

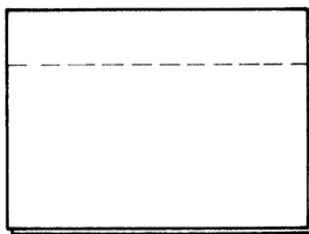


- Turn the diaper all the way over at its midpoint.

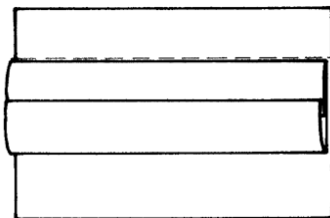


- Place the diaper under the baby.
- Bring the front of the diaper (corners B and C) up between the baby's legs. Tuck in B and C.

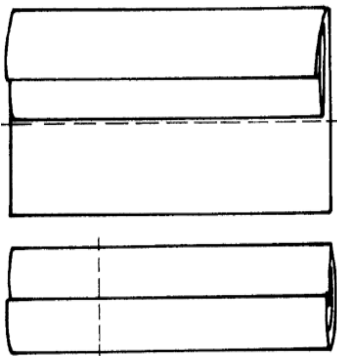
NIGHTTIME DIAPER: For maximum absorbency, this diaper fold gives 12 layers of cloth in the center, but it is still easy to Snappi and it fits snug and trim.



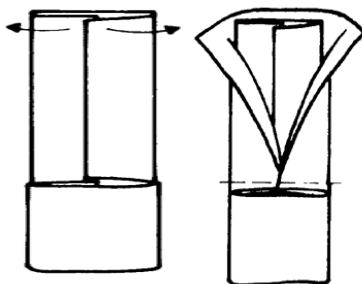
1. Stack two toddler-size diapers.



2. Fold the sides of the top diaper in to form a pad.



3. Fold the sides of the bottom diaper over the pad.
4. Fold a small portion of the stack up in front.



5. Unfold the sides of the bottom diaper in the back to form two wings.
6. Place the diaper under the baby. Bring the front of the diaper up between the baby's legs.



7. Bring the wings around from the back and pin. Because the wings are from the bottom diaper only, you will be using a Snappi on only one layer of cloth to the front of the diaper.
